A grade of C or better is required in all courses in teacher education, supporting courses, elementary education, and DHH. Also a GPA of 2.5 is required in each area. Students are required to develop a Portfolio which will be evaluated at designated times during their program. Before enrolling at other institutions for courses, approval from the Dean of the College of Education must be obtained..
