- (3) a master's degree or a fifth-year program (GPA of a minimum of 3.0 for a master degree or 2.5 for fifth-year)

Program Completion: A "B" average is required for certification. No credit is awarded for any course carrying a grade lower than a "C". In SED 816, a "S" is required on the course evaluation instrument as well as on the journal. Note: SED 816 is a six credit hour course. All other courses in the program must be completed prior to registering in this course. A student must enroll in SED 816 within three years of completing SED 810 and 814. All required courses (EAD 801, SED 810, 814, and 816) must be completed within five years. To register in SED 816, prior approval of the advisor is required.
