Beginning in the Spring 2002 term, students admitted to a Master's degree or graduate certification program in the Department of Special Education will be required to build a professional portfolio as evidence of their ability to meet Kentucky Experienced Teacher Standards and as evidence of their content knowledge, pedagogical skills, and dispositions. The professional portfolio will be submitted, reviewed, and scored by the student's graduate advisor in the student's final semester in the program. Completion of all mandated Praxis exams for graduate certification programs continues to be required before the student is recommended for certification. In the M.A.Ed. program, a passing score on oral and/or written comprehensive exams continues to be required.
